



## Leukios Demosthenous

Leukios Demosthenous is a graduate of the School of Theology at Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. His postgraduate degree, titled "Love and Death according to Symeon the New Theologian," served as a catalyst for his further exploration of the mysteries of life, death, and the Love that governs universal manifestations beyond.

In 2005, he founded the "Eastern Music School," where he taught the subject of Eastern microtonal music and its therapeutic properties as its director.

In 2006, he obtained a diploma as a "Cellular Medicine Consultant" through written examinations from the "Alliance for Health," under the internationally renowned German cardiologist Dr. Matthias Rath.

In 2011, he began a series of personal analyses, and in 2016, following numerous seminars and personal studies of the written works of Sigmund Freud, Jacques Lacan, Carl Jung, and other internationally renowned psychoanalysts, he established the Ecclesiological Anthropological Direction of Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy. This approach is grounded in the theory of ecclesiology (and ancient Greek anthropology), christology, and psychology, drawing from the terms of the Fourth Ecumenical Council of 451 AD.

Since then, he has been teaching collaborative psychoanalysis, nutrition (as a cellular medicine consultant), microtonal music, and the secret theology of the East in general.

His methodology in psychoanalytic direction harmoniously combines methods, primarily from the ancient Greek Epicurean school, Freud, Lacan, Jung, and, above all, his own unique perspective.

Today, he lives and works in Cyprus, where he has resided since 2006.
